

Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement/Junior Market Certification Form

This form must be signed by the Junior Market Exhibitor, Parent/Legal Guardian and notarized and returned at tag-in in May for large animals and at tag-in in June for small animals.

We, the junior exhibitor and parent/guardian, certify that we have read, understand, and will abide by the Livestock Premium List and rules and regulations of the Trinity Valley Exposition. We further certify that we have not administered, and to the best of our knowledge, this entry, Broilers, Commercial Heifer, Goat, Lamb, Rabbits, Steer, or Swine (circle all that exhibitor will be showing) has not received any substance not approved by the FDA and/or USDA for consumption by animals. This entry is not, nor will it be, within any withdrawal time relative to the administration of any drug, chemical, or feed additive approved by the FDA and/or USDA by the time the animal(s) is officially weighed in at the Show.

If an animal requires emergency treatment while on the Grounds, the exhibitor shall notify the Livestock Committee Chairman prior to the treatment of the animal, and the Livestock Committee Chairman shall witness such emergency treatment of the animal. Only licensed veterinarian will be allowed to administer any drug, chemical, or feed additive to the animal. If the drug, chemical, or feed additive is administered by the veterinarian prior to the time the animal is shown and judged at the Show, the animal will be disqualified. If the drug, chemical, or feed additive is administered by the veterinarian after the time the animal has been shown and judged in the Show, the animal will not be disqualified, but the animal must be withheld from slaughter for the full elimination time of any such drug, chemical, or feed additive administered to the animal, so that, the animal is drug and chemical free at the time of its slaughter.

We certify that we understand that the Trinity Valley Exposition reserves the right to condemn and/or disqualify any animal either live or slaughtered, or any animal found with a quantity of diuretic or any unapproved medication and the exhibitor will forfeit all auction sale proceeds and awards received. If the animal is disqualified, the exhibitor or immediate family of an exhibitor will be barred from exhibiting at TVE for a period of three (3) years. If an animal(s) is disqualified for testing positive and /or the carcass condemned at slaughter the class will not be charged. Any exhibitor or any immediate family of an exhibitor of a animal producing a sample having a quality of diuretic or unapproved medication of any kind will forfeit all rights and privileges to exhibit livestock for three (3) years at the TVE.

EXHIBIT OWNERSHIP: We, the junior exhibitor and parent/guardian, certify that the Market Animal Project(s) is an actual part of the exhibitor’s current project; under his/her individual management and/or regular care on the home residence or have an approved Off Premises Form on file in the TVE office.

RULES AND REGULATIONS: We agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the TVE, and do understand that the official rules in the Fair office take precedence over the rules on an entry form and/or the catalog.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY: Trinity Valley Exposition, including its officers, directors, agents, servants, and/or employees herein called “TVE” and the Owner and /or Exhibitor agree that TVE will in no case be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to the person, animals, or property of Exhibitors, Exhibitor’s agents, servants, family, and /or employees, regardless of how such loss, damage, or injury is occasioned and by whom. TVE and Exhibitors further agree that Exhibitor will protect, indemnify and save harmless TVE from any and all claims, suits, and /or judgments (including the cost of defense of any such claim and/or suit by Fair) brought by anyone as a result of any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animals, or property occasioned by say action or inaction of Exhibitors, either solely or conjunction with Fair or anyone else.
